

Year: 6 Subject: RSHE Block 4 Living in the Wider World Unit: Basic first aid; Environment/Community; Careers/Aspiration

Overview:

During this sequence of learning, pupils will know when it is safe to give first aid and when it is safe to call for help. They will build on their understanding of first aid by knowing what to do in different emergency situations. This sequence will allow children to explore the wider community by participating in events. Pupils will be exposed to a range of careers which will enable them to broaden their horizons when they leave Reffley Academy.

- It is important to stay where you are in an emergency until the emergency services arrive.
- In an emergency our body tells us to react and panic, rather than thinking carefully. Our body makes us emotional and therefore putting ourselves in danger. This is why it is important to stay calm.
- Community events are important to attend as they allow you to interact with others. This could lead to new friendships that may benefit you later in life.
- Attending careers events are important because they allow you to broaden your horizons and look at different opportunities ready for your future. It is important to gain aspirations ready for you to explore as you move onto secondary school.

Emergency call handler

Someone who answers 999 calls. They will ask you questions about the emergency.
