## What should I know already?

## Louise Bourgeois

(1911 - 2010) Louise Bourgeois was an artist and sculptor Bourgeois loved spiders, and she made hundreds of drawings and sculptures of them throughout her career. She described the spider as an artist. It could spin thread and create magnificent webs. She called many of the sculptures 'Maman', which is French for mother.
