





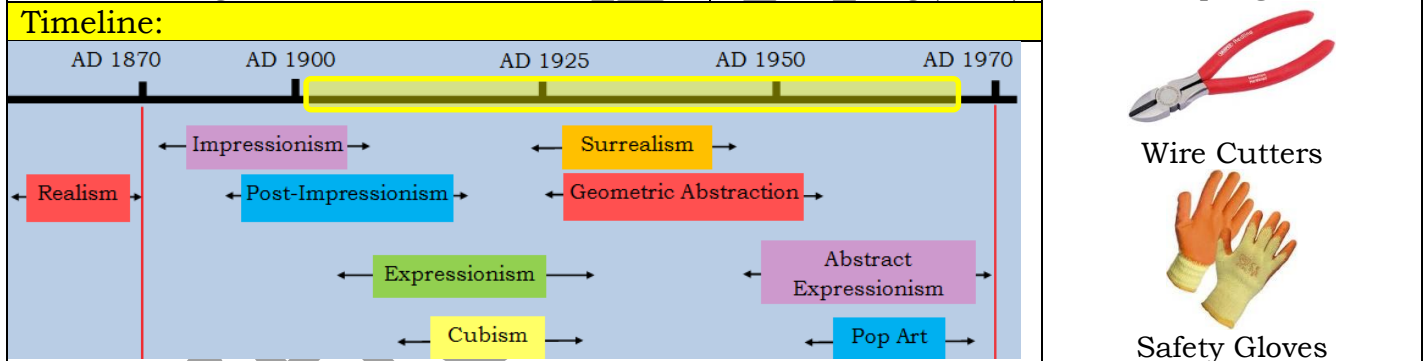

<p style="text-align: center;">Alberto Giacometti</p> <p>(1901 - 1966) Alberto Giacometti was a Swiss painter and sculptor. In Paris (1922) he studied sculpture with the sculptor Antoine Bourdelle. Giacometti's work was influenced by cubism and surrealism. Vocabulary I will need to know:

Surrealism	An art movement (started in the 20 th Century) that tries to express the subconscious mind (e.g. dreams, fantasies).
Sculpt	To make by carving or moulding.
Sculptor	An artist who makes sculptures.
Sculpture	The art or craft of making statues or other objects by carving, chiselling, or moulding. A sculpture is also any object made in this way.
Elongated	Something that has been made longer, drawn out or extended.
Wire	A thin rod or thread of metal.
Frame	A structure made of parts that are joined together and that support a larger object.
Figure	The shape of a human body.
Clay	Moist, stiff earth that is used for making brick, pottery, and tile.
