

Overview:

During this sequence of learning pupils will explore how needs and wants change over time and how people can future plan for these changes. Pupils will begin to think about some of the different jobs available and why people might choose these. They will also consider jobs that they may like to do when they are older. Pupils will consider why some people save money and how this is a way of future planning, they will also consider how they can look after money and keep it safe. Pupils will learn about potential risks of using the internet and how to best avoid these, they will also learn that not everything they see or hear on the internet is true and why it's important to check with a trusted adult if they are not sure about anything. Pupils will be encouraged to think about why age restriction laws exist and what the risks could be if a child were to do something meant for an adult.

What should I already know?

- Respect means treating people kindly and fairly.
- Empathy means trying to understand how someone else feels.
- When I show respect and empathy, I help others feel safe and valued.
- Rules help keep everyone safe and happy.
- When I make sensible choices and follow rules, I show that I care about others.
- The police help keep people safe in our community.
- They work to protect us and make sure everyone follows the law.
- Rules help everyone use a space safely, like classrooms, playgrounds, and shops.
- When I follow rules, I show respect for the place I am in.
