What will I be learning in this unit?

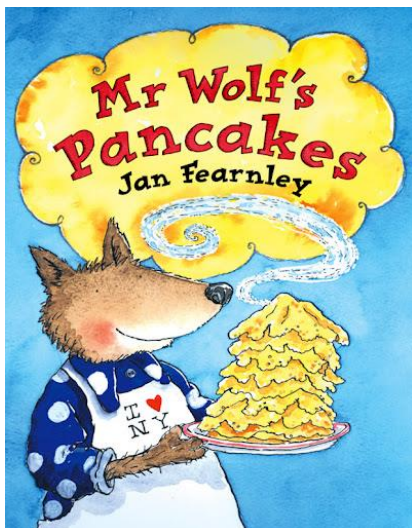
- To listen to a story.
