Overview:

This sequence of learning will focus on the text - Instructions by Neil Gaiman. We will be writing our own set of instructions for making a Moving Monster which is linked to our work in Design Technology. We will look at the features of the text and our purpose audience.

What will I be learning in this unit?

- To use a range of imperative verbs to instruct.
- To use a range of sentence starters including fronted adverbials.
- To use a range of conjunctions e.g. when, if, because, although to give further information.
- To use adverbs to qualify verbs e.g. slowly, carefully, accurately, quickly.
- To use commas to separate items in a list and to punctuate fronted adverbials.
- To use simple organisational devices e.g. headings and subheadings.
- To use and sustain the correct tense.
